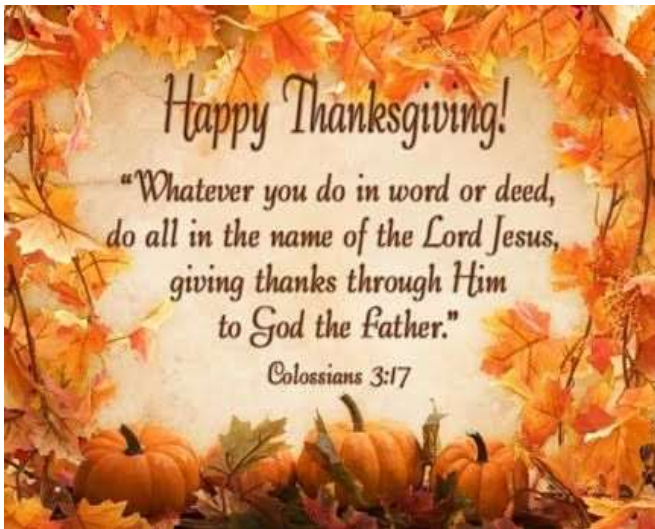

Feeding at St. Marc Prison and community

Dr. Max's 1st birthday wish in the US was to bring God glory by feeding over 700 police, prisoners, and poor in St. Marc. He is so thankful for gifts from friends here! One inmate is the mayor of Montrouis, shown with his mother and Dr. Max's mom. He is a Christian man and very respected, but there on false charges amid government corruption. When the gangs attacked the prison to get their members out, he refused to leave because he is such a good man. He knows God is his source of freedom and is a light in this dark place.

Dr. Max's mom and helpers cooked all night for this meal. We have been inside and saw over 50 people cells that should hold 10. Most can't lay down. There is no AC, a bucket for a latrine and the conditions are terrible. Several years ago, one of our mission teams gave all the inmates a care package with toiletries, treats, and a message of Jesus' love.
