We cannot imagine the utter chaos and desperation they live in. We are so thankful for everyone that supports and prays for this mission and them and for all the wonderful miracles seen this past year.

Deadly Gangs Gangs continue to terrorize and kill, rape, take hostages and destroy. In Port Au Prince, they burned several big pharmacies in March, and the wonderful Bernard Mevs hospital in December. Both Esdras & Dr Max have friends brutally beaten as hostages, gangs brag and wave their rifles, kill young and old, and block roadways demanding huge tolls. Food is so expensive, and danger is everywhere. Just this week, gangs attacked the peaceful farming town of Kescoff, killing a pastor and taking his house, an 83-year old woman as she tried to run and students as they took over Baptist Haiti Mission church and school in Qui Croit. Gangs have 85% of Port Au Prince, this gives even greater control over the capital's food supply. Please be in prayer for this evil to be stopped in the mighty name of Jesus.




